ACI Foundation Fellowships

GRADUATE and **UNDERGRADUATE** students studying concrete are eligible to apply for ACI's annual fellowships. Fellowship recipients receive an educational stipend valued at \$7000 to \$10,000, travel/expenses for participation in two ACI conventions, assistance in finding an industry mentor, and assistance finding a summer internship, if desired.
