“Code Requirements for Nuclear Safety-Related Concrete Structures (ACI 349) and Commentary”

The ACI Technical Activities Committee (TAC) approved processing the subject document through ACI's Normal Standardization Procedure in October 2011, as did the ACI Standards Board in September 2012.

Public Discussion and Closure

“Specifications for Environmental Concrete Structures (ACI 350.5)”

The ACI Technical Activities Committee (TAC) approved the draft standard subject to satisfactory committee response to TAC comments in November 2009. The committee responded adequately to TAC's comments and all balloting rules were met. On September 23, 2010, the Standards Board granted approval to release the draft standard for public discussion and to process it as an ACI standard. Public discussion was announced on December 1, 2010, and closed on January 17, 2011. The committee responded to the public discussion. TAC reviewed the closure and approved it on September 6, 2012. The Standards Board approved publication of the ACI standard on October 5, 2012.
