Applicant Eligibility

All applicants must have been in a concrete or construction related industry for less than 8 years. Years spent as a full-time student studying a construction related field do not count towards these 8 years. Current students or faculty members are not eligible for this contest.

Award

The winner of the contest will receive a cash prize, meant to support travel to attend the Fall 2017 ACI Convention in Anaheim, CA, as well as a waiver of the convention fees (\$493 value). Additionally, the winner will be announced in Concrete International, and their essay will be published online at www.concrete.org. The winner will also be presented with an award plaque at the Fall 2017 convention.

Selection Criteria and Award Notification

Final selection of the essay contest winner will be decided by a distinguished panel of concrete professionals. The award will be based on the quality of the essay, adherence to the essay topic, and the reference provided for the applicant. The winner will be notified by June 1st, 2017.

Application Requirements

The following materials must be submitted before midnight on January 31st, 2017.

1. Completed application form
2. Applicant's essay
3. 1-page resume
4. Reference letter (submitted electronically by reference, or mailed)
5. Short applicant biography (No longer than 150 words)
