ACI and ACHE signed an International Partnership Agreement in Feb. 26th 2018.

ACHE was founded in 1999 as the result of merging **ATEP** (Spanish Technical Association of Prestressed Concrete, founded in 1949 by Eduardo Torroja) and **GEHO** (Spanish Concrete Group, created in 1986).

In June 2017, ACHE changed its name from Spanish Concrete Association to Spanish Association of Structural Engineering.

ACHE currently has about 1000 members, mainly civil/structural engineers and architects. Several major companies from all over the world also support ACHE with corporate memberships.


