1. Call to order. The meeting was called to order at approximately 2:00 PM.

This meeting was devoted to discussing the status of the proposed document and whether the subcommittee wants to continue with the work. Following are the highlights of the discussion.

- a. Tracy Marcotte, Chair of 365, reported that the main committee had discussed the direction the subcommittee is taking with respect to the main committee document. The main committee was apparently ready to revise, yet again, the direction that the subcommittee is trying to go.
 - b. There was general agreement among the members present that the direction that the subcommittee is trying to go, preparing a document for practicing engineers on how to use models for evaluating service life of structures exposed to chlorides, is appropriate. This consensus included sticking with the outline for the document as approved by the subcommittee previously.
 - c. There was general agreement that the subcommittee did not want to take a step back and develop a new direction.
 - d. Given the above, Chair Holland expressed concern over the lack of progress on the document. Past promises to complete chapters so an entire document could be assembled have been largely ignored by several members.
 - e. **Two significant conclusions were drawn: First, the members responsible for the remaining chapters (see list above) must submit their chapters by the end of November, 2007. If the chapters are submitted, a document will be assembled and sent to subcommittee ballot before the Los Angeles convention. Second, if the remaining chapters are not prepared, the document will be abandoned and the subcommittee will be discharged.**

 9. Adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 3:30 PM.
