1. Welcome/Introductions

Chair Khan called the meeting to order at 2:02 pm. This was followed by self-introductions of those in attendance. Chair Khan counted voting members and noted that a quorum was not present (2:05 PM). Chair Khan noted that Burkan Isgor was added as a voting member to the committee. Additional voting members arrived later.

2. Approval of Minutes of Fall 2010 Pittsburgh, PA Meeting

Chair Kahn requested comments on the minutes from the Pittsburgh, PA meeting (Fall 2010). Andrea Schokker moved to approved the minutes and David McDonald seconded the motion. However, a quorum was not present and the minutes will have to be approved in the fall 2011 meeting.

3. Publication of ACI 222.3R

Chair Khan noted that accolades go out to David McDonald for getting the 222.3R document completed and that the document will be published soon. Chair Khan thanked all committee members for their participation.

4. Task Group Reports

222R Document – D. Trejo reported that 6 chapters (Chapters 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7) are out for ballot. Chair Khan noted that document has been in revision for approximately 5 years and that the revised document was rejected by TAC. Comments from TAC are being addressed, but it is not required that each comment be addressed. Chapter 4 is being revised now and is expected out by the end of the month.

222 2R Document – Chair Khan provided an update to the committee on the document. TAC conditionally approved but all concerns/comments must be addressed within 2 years of when the comments were provided to the committee. The document has had 4 key players (West, Schokker, Marcotte, and Poston) that have done a great job with the document and it would be disappointing if document comments from TAC are not addressed soon. Chair Khan emphasized the need to complete the document. D. Trejo will work with key players to ensure comments are addressed in a timely manner.

Chloride Limits - Trejo reported that he and Weyers submitted an abstract to the Hope Schupack Symposium on the topic. This may lead to an additional paper for CI.

5. Resolution of Negatives

ACI 222R – Trejo presented existing negatives to the ballots. Because the ballots had not yet closed (but would be closing soon), the committee discussed potential solutions to resolve the negatives. These solutions were documented and will be balloted with a letter ballot.

6. Report on Sessions

Chair Khan noted that a symposium for Hope and Schupack will be held in Dallas, TX (Spring 2012). Chair Khan has received 11 abstracts and he would like to receive more. Chair Khan is requesting another 9 abstracts (minimum) for the symposium by the end of this week. Chair Khan also requested two papers/presentations to tribute B. Hope and M. Schupack. Andrea Schokker agreed to do paper/presentation to tribute M. Schupack and Carolyn Hansson agreed to do paper/presentation to tribute for B. Hope.
