ACI Fall 2011 Convention Cincinnati, OH

Tuesday, October 18, 2011

1. Call to Order
 - T. Marcotte called the meeting to order at 10:05 am.
2. Self Introductions and membership

5. Development of the Document
 - a. All reviewed the comments received from the ballot (attached), and negatives were reviewed. Specific consensus comments from the meeting included:
 - i. In a few sections, topics that trended toward new Design issues would likely be better presented in the Design subcommittee. After this information is shared, a cross-reference can be inserted.
 - ii. In the sections related to deterioration, the information should be streamlined, and cross-referenced with the other ACI committee documents rather than summarizing it within this chapter. There was consensus that the work as written was/is excellent, but might be over-detailed and removes emphasis from the focal points (long-term management, rehabilitation, adaptation, etc.).
 - iii. There should be more focus upon the repair/rehabilitation/adaptation strategies and how the concrete built environment is inherently durable. It was understood that many buildings, bridges, etc. are demolished for functional obsolescence and not a lack of durability.
 - b. The document will need to be revised and reballoted. There is cautious optimism that this final review will permit the document to be sent to the main committee for ballot.
